DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This work involves administrative responsibility for coordinating and directing the operations of the Investigations Unit of the Montgomery County Department of Social Services. Under the general supervision of the Commissioner of Health and Human Services, the Coordinator plans and supervises the work of an investigative staff, establishes and implements investigative and unit procedures, interprets and enforces adherence to social services' policies and directives, and coordinates the work of the Investigations Unit with other DSS units and County departments. Work is assigned and reviewed through conference and submission of reports, with leeway given for the exercise of initiative and independent judgement within defined policies and goals. This position involves the coordination of research and field investigation in cases where there is allegation or suspicion of improper amounts of payments, failure to make support payments and attempted or actual welfare fraud along with the coordination of evidence gathering and documentation to develop legally acceptable cases. Supervision is exercised over employees assigned to the Social Services Investigation Unit. Incumbents may be required to successfully pass a background check. Does related work as required.
