The incumbent will perform all related duties required. Supervision is not a requirement for this position.

Admission to the Bar in New York State. Applicants must provide verification of their Admission to the Bar in New York State and provide a current Certificate of Good Standing from the New York State Supreme Court, Appellate Division. Minimum of three (3) years of experience in a District Attorney's Office prosecuting felony level crimes.

Possession of a valid NYS driver's license is required at the time of appointment and maintained during employment.
